Dual Application to YYAS & Yale Young Global Scholars (YYGS)

YYAS applications from students who will be between 16-18 years old by July 16, 2023 have the option to be reviewed and considered for both YYAS and YYGS.

YYAS is a one-week program in July or August 2023, and offers both residential (in Zimbabwe) and online (virtually via Zoom) options. YYAS is designed for secondary school students between the ages of 14-18 living on the African continent. The online program is free for all admitted students, while the residential program includes a program fee to cover meals and operational expenses. YYAS typically offers admission to around 300 applicants.

YYGS is a two-week program in June or July 2023, and takes place residentially on Yale's campus in New Haven, Connecticut, USA. YYGS offers need-based financial aid (up to full tuition coverage) to qualified high-achieving, low-income (HALI) students between 16-19 years old, and helps those students fundraise where needed as well. YYGS typically offers admission to around 2,000 applicants.

**Residential Notes: YYAS Residential will offer admission to ~50 students, and is open to students across all countries in Africa. Students will reside at a school in Zimbabwe (details coming soon!) for one week. Given the limited duration of the program, YYAS has strict attendance expectations where students are unable to miss even one day of the program. Students who successfully finish the program will receive a pdf YYAS Certificate of Completion that can be added to college and university applications. YYAS Residential provides free housing and all academic curriculum materials, but in order to participate, each student will need to pay a program fee of \$175 to cover all meals and operational expenses during the program, and each student must be able to travel to and from Zimbabwe, which they will coordinate and pay/fundraise for themselves.
